GUILDLINES FOR INERT LANDFILL

No household garbage, cardboard, paper, books, or magazines will be accepted at the inert landfill.

Tree pile

Allowed: tree trunks, branches, grass clippings, leaves and garden waste.

Not Allowed: any kinds of processed wood (examples: plywood, 2X4's, any kinds of human altered building materials and/or scraps)

There is a designated area for appliances. Appliances include but are not limited to washers, dryers, ranges, water heaters, dishwashers, microwaves, copiers, furnaces, air conditioners, dehumidifiers, refrigerator and freezers; refrigerator and freezer doors must be removed; Freon must be removed from air conditioners, dehumidifiers, refrigerators and freezers. White goods are placed in a gated area and you will need to contact the City Superintendent at 403-2300 to get access to this area. The cost to place a white good in the landfill is \$10 payable at City Hall.

Computers and/or TV's can be put in the rolloffs that are in the spring and fall for cleaning at City Hall.

The landfill is for only the residents of the City of Wyndmere. The landfill is open unless the ground has been saturated. The landfill is closed in the winter. If you need access call the City Superintendent at 403-2300.

This Inert Landfill is State regulated.
